

Hazardous Material Transport Compliance Checklist

Documentation

- Shipping papers completed and accessible
- Emergency response info available
- Driver has proper licenses, endorsements, and required training
- Manifest, permits, and other required documents included

Labeling & Placarding

- Proper hazard labels on all packages
- Vehicle properly placarded (front, back, both sides)
- Labels & placards not obscured or damaged

Packaging

- Approved containers/packaging in good condition
- Seals and closures intact
- No leaks, dents, rust, or damage

Handling & Loading

- Cargo securely braced and blocked
- Segregation requirements met (incompatibles separated)
- Spill kits and emergency equipment on board
- Fire extinguisher present and inspected

General Compliance

- No smoking or ignition sources near hazardous material
- Route restrictions checked (e.g., tunnels, bridges)
- All required PPE (personal protective equipment) present
