Obligations of the Researcher

- To use Confidential Information solely for research purposes authorized by the Institution
- Not to disclose Confidential Information to any third party without prior written consent from the Institution
- To take appropriate security measures to protect Confidential Information from unauthorized access or disclosure
- To promptly report any breach of confidentiality to the Institution

Duration

The Researcher's obligations under this Agreement shall remain in effect during and after the period of research, unless and until the Confidential Information becomes publicly available through no fault of the Researcher.

Return of Information

Upon completion or termination of research activities, the Researcher agrees to return or destroy all Confidential Information as directed by the Institution.
